As a speech therapist, you will work with students to assess, diagnose, and treat speech and language disorders. Responsibilities include conducting evaluations, developing individualized education plans, and collaborating with teachers and parents to support students' communication needs. This position is a district wide position and serves students from early childhood through grade 12 and beyond if appropriate.

Requirements:

Master's Degree in Speech-Language Pathology

Certificate of Clinical Competence in Speech-Language Pathology (CCC-SLP) preferred

Licensure or ability to be licensed as a Speech Therapist

Responsibilities:

Conduct assessments to determine students' communication strengths and areas of need

Develop and implement individualized education plans to address speech and language goals

Provide direct therapy services to students in individual, group, and classroom settings

Monitor student progress and adjust goals as needed

Collaborate with teachers, parents, and other school personnel to support students' communication skills in the classroom and other settings

Maintain accurate and up-to-date documentation of services provided and student progress, including Medicaid billing

Participate in team meetings, professional development activities, and school-based initiatives
